



The Jewish gap year for aspiring professionals

Program's goal: Experience One Year - Endless Possibilities

You can spend an entire year, advancing yourself both professionally and personally, meanwhile having a Jewish experience of a lifetime.

JAcademy is a 10-month gap-year program for young adults between 18-25, offering a unique program that includes:

- ✓ Jewish learning
- ✓ Networking and Development courses
- ✓ 3 Professional internships
- ✓ 4 Countries

The program consists of 4 classroom semesters, with each JAcademy student participating in an internship opportunity between each semester.

Participants obtain internships in Berlin, Jerusalem and London, culminating the year with a highly intensive networking trip to New York.

Internships are tailored to meet each JAcademy student's preference.


Summer Beit Midrash Programs 2018 - Yesod Jewish Learning Scholarships

Jewish Learning and Leadership Retreats

Program's goal: Moishe House provides vibrant Jewish community for young adults by supporting leaders in their 20s as they create meaningful home-based Jewish experiences for themselves and their peers. We envision Moishe House as the global leader of pluralistic Jewish life for adults in their 20s. We facilitate a wide range of experiences, so that they have the leadership, knowledge and community to enrich their Jewish journeys. Moishe House Jewish Learning and Leadership Retreats are multi-day, immersive learning experiences that train Jewish young adults worldwide in ritual and program skills. They are:

- ✓ Immersive: Enter a new (head)space that's away from the everyday.
- ✓ Inclusive: Learn in a truly pluralistic environment no judgements or prerequisites.
- ✓ Interactive: Learn while DOING, through hands-on sessions taught by incredible Jewish educators.
- ✓ Implementable: We focus on teaching TANGIBLE skills, which will serve you in your role as a Jewish leader
 - Moishe House and beyond.

Where it happens: All over the world, including in European countries.

When it happens: Between two and three times a year in Europe, altogether around 15 staff-led + around 100 peer-led retreats a year

Pardes European Leadership Fellowship

Program's goal: The Pardes European Leadership Fellowship is open to Jewish students and leaders (ages 20-35) from across Europe who are passionate about building community and eager to enrich their personal and professional identities through the in-depth study of classic Jewish texts and core Jewish ideas. Fellows participate full-time in the Pardes Year Program in Jerusalem and Fellows who are eligible for Masa scholarships will receive tuition scholarships of \$1,000 off tuition while fellows who are ineligible for Masa will receive \$2,000 off tuition for the year. A limited number of Fellows will also be awarded a living stipend of \$2,000 for the year.* The Fellowship cohort meets monthly for special guest speakers and workshops and fellows work closely with Pardes staff to bring open, relevant and rich Jewish learning back to their home communities.
